The church staff continues to steward available resources well and closely monitors available funds. The proposed budget is designed to meet the needs of the church and ensure our staff are properly cared for. We are still exploring opportunities to save money on staff health insurance without significantly impacting our staff. The budget also reflects hiring a Preaching Pastor with a start date of 6/1/24.
